## **Goalkeeper Coach Postgraduate Studentship Opportunity**

The Hartpury Women's Football Academy are looking for an enthusiastic and highly motivated individual to join and provide goalkeeper coaching for our British University and Colleges Sport (BUCS) teams and Association of College (AoC) teams for the upcoming 2024-25 academic year.

The Postgraduate Studentship offers a part-funded place on the Hartpury University MSc Sports Coaching degree, studied over one or two years to enable the candidate to combine coaching with postgraduate study.

### Studentship responsibilities will include the following:

- Assisting with Hartpury Sports Academy Football programme in the area of expertise / specialism (Football Goalkeeping).
- Provide progressive and imaginative goalkeeping sessions to our academy goalkeepers aged between 16 –
   23 years old.
- The role would require 8hrs a week commitment distributed between session preparation and delivery.

o Friday: 14:00 – 15:00

- · Consult with coaches and management on a weekly basis to ensure best practice and objectives are met.
- They will lead and implement a strategy to develop goalkeepers technical and tactical understanding.
- Contribute to the football academy experience building relationships with both staff and students to develop and improve yourself and the programme.
- Promote and represent Hartpury University and Hartpury Football in a professional manner.
- Completing your postgraduate research project alongside our university strategic direction with the aim of
  actively contributing to our evolving postgraduate research and knowledge exchange community and
  impacting our applied Sports Academy provision

### **Person Specification**

- Preferably a 2.1 undergraduate degree in sports coaching or related sports field (although this is open to discussion based on experience)
- The successful candidate must have experience in playing / coaching goalkeeping to players aged 16 or above.
- Desirable qualification; FA level 1 in Coaching Goalkeeping or higher.
- Excellent inter-personal and communication skills and the ability to deliver engaging and progressive sessions.
- The successful candidate will be a highly motivated and passionate individual who wants to develop both themselves and the student athletes.
