Food groups: The various types of food: protein,

carbohydrate, fat and vitamins and minerals.

Arable farm: A farm that produces crops.

Pastoral farm: A farm that rears animals.

Mixed farm: A farm that produces crops and rears

animals.

Harvest: Gathering in crops for selling.

Organic: A method of farming that doesn't use

chemicals.

Free range: Allowing animals to spend over half of their

life outdoors.
