Studentship responsibilities will include the following:

- Assisting with Hartpury University Footballprogramme in the area of strength & conditioning
- Lead the daily running of the S&C sessions and assist with the long-term planning of physical development
 of the athletes
- · Consult with senior management on a weekly basis to ensure best practice and objectives are met
- The Football Academy would require 12 hours a week commitment distributed between gym, field training, matches, meetings and administrative duties. These hours will be embedded into your workload from the taught modules that you will undertake. The exact session timings will be dictated by which team you will be working with
- Completing your postgraduate research project alongside our university strategic direction with the aim of
 actively contributing to our evolving postgraduate research and knowledge exchange community and
 impacting our applied Sports Academy provision.

- Preferably a 2.1 undergraduate degree in strength & conditioning orrelated sports science field (although this is open to discussion based on application)
- Experience in strength and conditioning
- Excellent inter-personal and communication skills and ability to deliver a variety of face-face sessions
- Ability to work a part of a team, and to lead and coordinate others where appropriate.
